Hello Year One Parents,

In reading this week we are focusing on reading with fluency as a strategy. When reading students will focus on accuracy, expression, punctuation and will re-read words when something doesn't make sense. We will continue reading our class novel that the students are loving, and will continue our tracking processes; making predictions, text to self connections and visualising.

In writing this week we will continue to work on handwriting and correctly using lower and upper- case letters in sentences. Our genre of writing this week is focusing on Recounts, and students will have the chance to plan (story map) and then write a recount based on something they have done.

For spelling our focus is on Bossy e, and exploring how the silent e makes the vowel say its name!

In maths this week, we will continue the exploration of 2D and 3D shapes, but our focus will be identifying edges(sides) and vertices (corners) of shapes/objects. Students will engage in activities that will sum up everything they have learnt about place value concepts.
