The 3/4s have enjoyed another fantastic week here at Woori Yallock Primary School.

Week 6 (next week)

In Reading, we are learning about creating tracks within our Reader's Notebook. We will be reading a picture story called 'The Raft' and looking at how the character changes and develops over the course of the story.

In Writing, we are learning to create engaging narratives. Students will be working on how to plan, structure and edit a narrative based on a prompt. Students will include emotion through description throughout their piece.

In Maths, we are continuing to explore place value, specifically looking at how to add and subtract numbers vertically. Within our geometry unit, students will continue exploring different types of angles that are within shapes. Within problem solving, students will be using a variety of strategies they have learnt to try to solve worded problems multiple ways.

In Spelling, we are inquiring about the spelling rules for prefixes and suffixes and how they change the meaning of base words.
