PURPOSE

The wearing of school uniform creates a feeling of belonging to the school and conveys to the community a sense of pride and unity in the school.

The purpose of the Student Dress Code is to outline Woori Yallock Primary Schools requirements for student dress and appearance and to provide information about uniform purchase and support, dress code implementation and exemption processes.

The Student Dress Code aims to:

- install a sense of pride for the school by the wearing of school uniform
- provide the community with a way to instantly recognise children from the school when on excursions or participating in sporting activities
- provide an opportunity for families to sell their second hand clothing or to offer these to other families via second hand uniform shop
- provide sun protection in line with the schools sun smart policy
- ensure safety in terms of foot protection and jewellery

SCHOOL UNIFORM

All School uniform should be clearly labelled with the student's name.

- Jumpers:** Royal green windcheater with WYPS logo, royal green button up jacket with WYPS logo, royal green hooded windcheater with WYPS logo. Year 6 button jacket.
- Shirts:** Royal green/white polo shirt with WYPS logo.
- Dresses/Skorts:** Checked dresses (green and white check) in school format, winter skirt/tunic (royal green, black, white) in school format and skorts (black).
- Pants:** Plain back pants or leggings- no stripes, patterns, cut outs, prints or logos.
- Socks/tights:** school socks in either white or black/full length black tights.

Hats:	Royal green broad brimmed slouch hat, royal green bucket hat or royal green legionnaire's hat
Footwear:	Sensible closed toe shoes with socks. Shoes must be black.
Jewellery:	Watches and small earrings are permitted.
Hair:	For the purpose of safety and the management of head lice we ask that all students with hair longer than shoulder length have it neatly tied back.
Make up:	make up is not necessary and not permitted this includes nail polish

IMPLEMENTATION

All children are expected to wear a neat and clean school uniform. If a child is unable to wear the correct uniform the teacher should be notified and the matter resolved as quickly as possible.

EXEMPTION

Should any parent have a religious, medical or other reason for exemption from any part of this uniform please discuss with the principal.

** Free dress days will be allowed at the discretion of the Principal.

HEALTH & SAFETY

School uniform hats must be worn outside from mid-August (exact date to be set by the school annually) to 30 April and on any other day prescribed by the school. School uniform hats may also be worn outside of this time period, by parent or student choice.

Hats are not to be worn inside.

Students are permitted to wear sunglasses during outdoor activities. Sunglasses should be close-fitting, wrap-around that meet the Australian Standards 1067 and cover as much of the eye area as possible.

PURCHASING THE UNIFORM

School uniforms can be purchased at Lowes in Lilydale Marketplace.

SECOND HAND UNIFORM

Second hand uniforms may be available for sale at the school for \$5 per item or as labelled.

**Arrangements can be made for funding via State Schools Relief for families experiencing economic hardship.
